Scholarship Information

 Have 2 people fill out the Letter of Recommendation form. They should

- 4) Commitment to Community Service
 All applicants must affirm their commitment to Public Service in the Community of Alviso.

Box 1012, Alviso, CA 95002 and/or by contacting Judy Santiago to make arrangements to personally hand-deliver it directly to her. Incomplete submissions cannot be considered. Please note: No submissions will be returned.

Scholarship Amounts

The amount for Scholarships and/or other requested amounts will depend on the amount of money we have available to disburse this year and will be considered by the Board of Directors.

Scholarship Recipients

All Scholarship recipients will be notified by the Board of Directors. All decisions are at the discretion of the Board of Directors and are final and all scholarship monies will be paid directly to the scholarship recipient.

The "Santa Visits Alviso" Foundation Board of Directors looks forward to your submission and wishes you the best in your endeavors. The application process opens each year on March 1st and closes on May 31st so any application postmarked after May 31st will not be accepted and/or returned.
